Dear Secretary Staples,

Re Bus Routes 470 and 431 Interchange at Haymarket

We wrote to you 12 months ago (copy attached) requesting the alteration of where the buses stop at Haymarket. We were asking for this change so the buses stopped closer to the Light Rail which runs up George Street into the city. The stop closest to the light rail being at the corner of Pitt and Barlow street, the stop at which the buses were stopping being some 250 metres further away in Hay Street opposite Belmore Park. We were making this request to enable an easier interchange for public transport users coming from Glebe/ Forest Lodge who are travelling toward Town Hall/ Wynyard and Circular Quay.

For some months during 2020 this alteration was made and our members were grateful and satisfied with this change. However as of 23 November 2021 the Bus Stop was changed back to stopping in Hay Street causing difficulty for less mobile users and inconvenience for other users. We are requesting that the 431 & 470 buses stop at the bus stop at Pitt and Barlow Street.

The Glebe Society has approximately 400 members who live in Glebe and Forest Lodge.
