Dear Secretary Staples,

We write on behalf of members who are affected by the poor interchange arrangements between the bus and the tram at Central.

We have a number of elderly members who find the current walk from the bus stop for 431 & 470 (our local buses) to the Light Rail Stop for the Tram along George street of approximately 450 metres too difficult. The closest Bus Stop for the 431 & 470 for the change is in Hay Street opposite Belmore Park. The closest Light Rail Stop for the George Street Light Rail is in Rawson Place, approximately 450 metres walk. There is a closer Bus Stop on Pitt Street, about 200 metres from the Light Rail, but this is not used by the 431 and 470.

We believe that people should be encouraged to catch public transport and that the various public transports should be accessible and convenient to their users. We request a review of where the 470 and 431 stops be made so it is closer to the Light Rail Stop. We enclose a Map illustrating our issue.
